4x1 8K HDMI® Switch

Installation Instructions

- 1) Power off all devices.
- 2) Connect the supplied power adapter to the DC 5V port.
- 3) Connect a display to the HDMI OUT port of the switch.
- 4) Connect HDMI devices to the HDMI IN ports of the switch.
- 5) Power on devices and change the display input to the switch's HDMI input.

Operating Instructions

- To change HDMI input, press the **INPUT** button on the front panel of the switch, or with the included remote. An LED will be lit when switched to an active input.
- To toggle auto-switching, hold down the **INPUT** button for 3 seconds. The **AUTO** LED will be lit when auto-switching is enabled.
- To activate the remote, please remove the plastic tab protecting the battery.

Note: The remote must have line of sight to the switch IR sensor.

Troubleshooting Tips

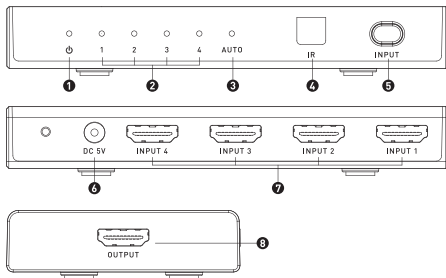
1. For 4K 120Hz or 8K feature support, connect the switch to a supported port on the display.
2. Advanced HDMI features must be manually enabled on some televisions.
3. 2 meters / 6.6 feet or shorter 8K HDMI cables are recommended.

- 3) AUTO LED (White) Indicates the auto-switching mode
- 4) IR Sensor For remote signals
- 5) INPUT button. Press to switch inputs. Press and hold for 3 seconds to toggle auto switching
- 6) DC 5V port
- 7) HDMI IN ports
- 8) OUTPUT port
