Installation Instructions


- 1) Plug the micro-USB cable into the video streamer
- 2) Connect your Ethernet patch cable to the adapter and your internet router
- 3) Plug the USB-A cable to a USB wall charger
- 4) Connect the video streamer to your TV
- 5) Select a 'wired connection' from the TV menu (if needed)

Troubleshooting Tips

- Video streamer must be USB-powered (not AC powered)
- . Check that the LED is lit on the adapter
- . Do not use the USB power port on your TV
- · Test all your connected cables with another device
- . Try a different HDMI port on the TV
- Gen 1 Fire TV stick and smartphones are not supported
