# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

## OVERVIEW


The Cable Matters 4-Prong to 4-Wire 30A Dryer Appliance Cord is compatible with recent models of electric dryers with a 4-wire connection that require a 30 amp 4-prong receptacle for proper grounding. Most homes build after 2000 have 4-prong dryer outlets.

## ! CAUTION




- Electrical cords can be hazardous! Misuse can result in fire or death by electrical shock.
- Installation by a qualified electrician is recommended.
- Rated for indoor use only in a dry location.
- DO Not use with a 3-slot dryer outlet or 3-wire dryer!
- Consult the documentation of your dryer for any special wiring.

## WIRING INSTRUCTIONS - READ BEFORE INSTALLING










- 1) Turn the power OFF at the electrical panel and set the dryer controls to the OFF position before installing.
- 2) Check for a 4-slot electrical outlet marked with 30A NEMA 14-30P. Do not use this cord with a 3-slot receptacle.
- 3) Unscrew the cover plate from the back of the dryer (a magnetic screwdriver is recommended).
- 4) Loosen the strain-relief bracket and slide it down the cord until needed. Use the dryer strainrelief fitting, if equipped, instead of the cord bracket.
- 5) Feed the cord through the opening in the back of the dryer and fan out the ring terminals.
- 6) Loosen the screws on the dryer wire terminals. Attach the GROUND/Green, HOT/Black, NEU-TRAL/WHITE, and HOT/Red wires as shown in the diagram below.
- 7) Tighten the terminal screws and double-check that they are securely attached.
- 8) Tighten the strain-relief bracket on the dryer or cord and check that the weight of the cable is supported by the bracket.
- 9) Completely insert the 4-prong plug into the receptacle until it is secure.
- 10) Restore power at the electrical panel and test the dryer.
